We do offer an itemized bill that you can submit to your insurance plan to seek full or partial reimbursement. **Please note, Medicaid does not pay for most travel related services.**

Inactive Polio Vaccine	\$70	Adults may need a single booster for travel

Chickungunya (Ixchiq)	\$420	
Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis)	\$75

Typhoid (Oral)	\$169	Includes 4 oral doses
